Trivia Fun: A Brief History of Father's Day

Mrs. John B. Dodd of Washington, campaigned for the idea of a “father’s day” holiday on 1909. She wanted a special way to honor her father, William Smart.

Mr. Smart, a Civil War veteran, was widowed when his wife died in childbirth with their sixth child. He was left to raise the newborn and his other five children by himself, while working a farm in eastern Washington. Mrs. Dodd came to realize as she matured, the great strength and love her father had shown raising her and her siblings alone.

The first Father’s Day was observed on June 19, 1910 in Spokane , Washington. Later in 1924, President Calvin Coolidge proclaimed his support to celebrate the holiday nationally. Ultimately in 1966, President Lyndon B. Johnson signed a presidential proclamation declaring official recognition of the 3rd Sunday in June as Father’s Day.

Today, Father’s Day is recognized as a time not only to honor your father, but all men who act or acted as a father figure.

So, to all you Dads out there, enjoy your day!
